As I mentioned previously, I've been working up a map of my observations of errors in the mapping of routes in Krause Basin that were to be retained under the 1988 Noisy Face Recreation Decision.

Those observations are included in the attached PDF, along with my observations of other routes that have either remained open due to popularity or have been intentionally cut open via unauthorized clearing.

We hope this is useful in arriving at a mutual understanding of what is out there on-the-ground, what unauthorized routes may need to be naturalized and what changes need to be made to the District and MVU maps to be consistent with the 1988 Decision.
